Representative Oscar Underwood of Alabama is looming up as one of the big figures of the house in the event that the democrats are in the majority in the sixty-second congress.

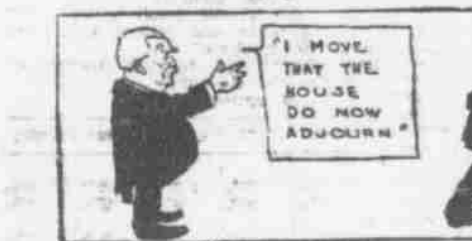
