

Lincoln Gets the Big End After Fourteen Innings; Cubs and Giants Each Win One Game

LINCOLN TAKES LONG GAME

Defeats Omaha After Fourteen Innings in Mud.

MAKES HAVE IT WON IN SIXTH

Lincoln took a fourteen-inning game away from Omaha Wednesday by the score of 7 to 5. It was not a contest from start to finish, despite the fact that the field was muddy and errors were frequent.

Omaha apparently had the game won in the sixth, the score being 5 to 3, but the Antelopes ran in two in the eighth on a hit, an error, a sacrifice and a three-bagger, and tied up the game. For four innings both teams played the right ball, but Lincoln made two runs in the fourth, with two singles and a double.

McCarthy started in the box for the Houckes, but was taken out in the third after three singles had been made off him. He had hit Cockman, forcing a run, and the Houckes, who were on the mound, were the lucky ones. McCarthy was cured from Milwaukee, was sent to the hospital, and was not given the support he needed to win on account of the muddy condition of the field. He was strong with the stick and hit two singles.

McCarthy, who worked in the box for Lincoln, went along the entire route in good shape, his bad inning being the sixth, when three hits, all singles, were made from his offerings. He also walked two men in this session. And from that period he kept the hits well scattered.

Umpire Clark started the game in Lincoln's favor, in the fourth, when he called Cobb's bunt a fair ball, although anyone sitting on the third base side of the grandstand could see that the ball rolled into foul territory. Clark was also off on balls and strikes when they counted.

Cobb reached first when Clark called his bunt fair, and went to second on Cockman's hit at first on a groundout from pitcher to first. Cobb went to third on Davis' out at first. Thomas hit a single to center and Cobb scored. Widenessau drove Thomas home by hitting a long double to center. With this lead of two against them, the Houckes were unable to do anything in their half of the fourth.

The game started as though it was going to be a battle of attrition pitching and errorless fielding, but in the third Lincoln made two runs when McCarthy was touched for a long double and he forced a run. In the next inning a run was made off by the Antelopes. Widenessau hit a sacrifice and went to the plate when Schlick threw high over Kane's head after he had fielded Clark's grounder.

Rourke took lead in sixth. Omaha made a score in the fourth when King rapped out a single, went to second on Kane's out to first and scored on Welch's two-bagger. In the sixth Omaha took the lead by getting four runs. Corridon reached first on a sacrifice, Cockman booted his grounder. King hit an easy one to McCarthy who fumbled and could not recover before Bertie jumped onto the sack. Corridon went to second. Kane hit a single and advanced the two men ahead of him one base, although with a fast diamond, Corridon could have scored. Welch drove home Corridon and Corridon was forced home. A wild pitch by McCarthy while Schlick was at bat led King in. Schlick fouled out to Clark. Graham hit a long, high fly to Davis and Welch scored before the fielder could throw to the plate. Gording drove a safe one to center and went to second when Stowers followed with a sacrifice. Stowers made the third out when Schlick hit one to Gagner who threw to second.

Lincoln ties up the game. Lincoln tied the score in the eighth. Cockman hit safe and went to second when Shotton muffed Davis' fly, after a long run. Thomas bunted to Kane who threw Cockman out at third. Davis went to second. Widenessau knocked a long three-bagger into center and Davis and Thomas scored. Stowers stood at this point and threw Clark out at first when he attempted to bunt. McGrath made the third out by hitting a high one to King.

Harry Welch played a spectacular game in eighth. He accepted five chances with out an error, three of which he grabbed out of the atmosphere at spots where it did not seem possible for the ball to be reached.
