LATIA FILES AS POPULIST
Goes to Lincoln to Confer with All Allied Parties.

DOBENT KNOW ABOUT PLATFORM
W. E. Andrews Writes Friends He Will Be Candidate for Governor—Here is Political News.

LINCOLN, July 11.—Special—James P. Latia of Thresher, who recently filed as a candidate for governor on the democratic ticket, came to Lincoln this morning and filed a petition to have his name placed on the popular ballot.

What are your constituents saying about your nomination? "The local average here" was Mr. Latia's first question. "Oh, I hear there is some talk going on, but I have not been outside of my home county and I really do not know what the voters are saying in the other counties of the State."

Andrews Not in Race
Mr. Andrews has written friends in Lincoln that he will not be a candidate for governor. For some time the name of Mr. Andrews has been used in the campaign, but the author of the treasury has definitely stated that he will not accept the honor. It was in a letter to a friend in Lincoln, July 10, that he said he would do what he could to bring the ground republicans across.

Yong is Set to Run
Mr. Yong was seen today and registered \$2500 high school bonds, voted by the city of Lincoln for a new school house. The bonds are 1 per cent and run twenty years, being optional at ten years. "I believe we will elect a republican representative to the House of Representatives," he said. "I believe the republican ticket will be elected throughout the State," said Senator Yong. "We have very few democrats in our part of the State and I hope to see some wherever in Nebraska." The republican administration of Washington has fulfilled its promise and with the people and it is getting more popular every day. The party is in good shape for victory this fall.

Executive Free from Scales.
