


### STATE SOLDIERS TO CAMP

Three Omaha Companies Prepare to Leave for Fort Riley.

REGIMENTAL OFFICERS ALSO GO

Soldiers Will Be Accompanied by the First Regiment Band-To Be Gone Twelve Days and Expect to Enjoy Selves.

Oue hundred and seventy officers and men of three Nebraska National Guard companies will leave Omaha Wednesday morning at 6 on a special Union Pacific train for Port Riley, Kan., to take part in the big midsummer maneuvers held there under the direction of the United States

The three companies are I. G and L. their officers being as follows: Company L (Thurston Rifles), Captain H. F. Elsasser commanding: first lieulenant, C. E. Burmester; second leiutenant,

Fred Schultz. Company G (Dahlman Rifles), Captain E E. Sterricker commanding; first lieutenant Eugene I. Harris; second lieutenant, C. W.

Company I (Millard Rifles). Captain Julius Wigg commanding; first lieutenant Gus Wigg; second lieutenant, Herbert Vos-

Three regimental officers will be on the train. These are Lieutenant Colonel W. E. Bachr, Captain and Battalion Adjutant Joseph A. Lillie and Captain and Commissary D. E. Lowe. Also three officers of the engineer corps. Captain Otto Haesman. First Lieutenant J. E. Maxwell and Second Lieutenant Edward Fienan, will be aboard. The Omaha companies will muster from fifty to fifty-four men each and are in condition to make a highly creditable show-

They will be gone twelve days, returning home Saturday, August 29. The guardsmen expect to have an even compment and the maneuvers will keep them pretty constantly on the go.

Besides the Oniaha companies traveling this train there will be the First regimnt band of Omaha and at Albion will be picked up the companies from Albian, chuyler and Fremont. The Bloomfield, Neb., bunch will be taken on at the Union

First Problem in Maneuvers. JUNCTION CITY, Kan., Aug. 16 .- The working out of the first military problem of the fall maneuvers at Fort Riley begap today with 1,500 men of the Kansas militia, under command of Brigadier Genoral Charles P. Crew and Brigadier General Charles i. Martin of Topeka taking part, To first accustom the troops to the reservation the problem is one which necessitates a minimum of marking. Recent rains have done much to put the ground of Pawnee flats, where the maneuvers are staged, in good condition. The Nebraska troops are expected in camp tomorrow.
