TWO GAMES FOR ROUKES

Whole Series with Wichita Goes to Credit of Locals.

IZZIES HAD NO CHANCE TO WIN

West and Rhodes, Pitching for Omaha, Had the Visitors Shut Out in Both Games But for a Bad Play.

Omaha, 2; Wichita, 1. Omaha, 2; Wichita, 0. The Roukes took both games of the double header from Wichita, thus winning all four games of the series. In both scraps the Roukes were all to the good and Wichita scarcely had a show.

West and Rhodes, pitching for Omaha, had the visitors shut out in both games but for a bad play. With the exception of the fourth inning, when the Roukes singled twice for two runs, the first game was a pitchers' battle.

In the fifth Schoonover went safe on a single and was sacrificed to second by Corridor. King flew out to left; Riggert struck a grounder down to short, but the shortstop failed to gather it in; Schoonover tallied and Riggert went to second. Another fly ball stranded on second, leaving Riggert stranded on second.

Wichita's solitary run was made in the fifth. Jarman singled; Middleton grounded to short and took first when Jarman was tipped at second. Corridor fumbled a grounder into left; Riggert stepped out to the pitcher and struck him with the bat.

Rhodes pitched a shutout in the second round, although the Izzies managed to connect with him for eight hits. Only two men saw third and six, all told, found their way to second. Every one of the eight hits was a single. On top of this, Rhodes sent nine Izzies down and out by the three-strike rule.

Omaha pointed Shackleford for nine hits in seven innings, and landed on Wright for three in the eighth. Riggert, who hit for a homer in Wednesday's game, was sacrificed to two three-baggers and a single in four times up. King struck for three bases and a single. Thompson lined out a double, and there were single game.

King brought home the one run of the fourth. He singled, took second on Shackleford's error and was sacrificed to first and home by Kane and Graham. In the sixth King lined out his three-bagger to right and was tallied by a three-bagger. Riggert died at third.
