SPOT CORN STILL GOES DOWN

Liquidation Among Holders Continues and Sentiment Seem to Favor the Bear Side of the Market.

Although the Monday showing of world shipments promised to be somewhat lower than the previous week, the dead weight of the expected total body of country and foreign wheat on hand was 1,341,000 bushels, or 1,000,000 bushels more than last week.
