

The municipal affairs committee of the Commercial club expects to appeal to the next legislature for a charter amendment so that lighting districts may be established by law.

This plan now regarded with general favor, seems necessary following the failure of negotiations with the Omaha Electric Light and Power company. The committee is alive to the necessity for concerted action in the matter of street lighting in order that separate blocks and individual houses may not choose and erect varying standards, with too at varying intervals, and thereby "discolor" the streets of the city with what would look like a lot of odds and ends.

"It is generally conceded," says the committee, "that the first expense of standards and installation should be borne by the property owners or business houses benefited, after which the city should bear the cost of maintenance, for the reason that the whole city will benefit by the improved condition."

Charter Limitations.
"It is much to be regretted that charter limitations now prevent the city from taking the matter up at once and bringing it to a successful conclusion, instead of compelling it to be left to action by business interests."

"But this gives the Commercial club an opportunity to show that it is alive to the importance and value of such an improvement, not only in the actual better lighting of the streets, but in excitation of civic pride. Well lighted streets are recognized as prime factors in the retail business, and while some side streets could not possibly be made really busy thoroughfares by any lighting, it is a matter of history that the heavy volume of travel takes to the better illuminated side of any street. Even in the matter of health, street lighting has its influence, as the tendency to litter up a brightly lighted street is much less than a dark and unattractive roadway. This is true even in the residential districts. Good light unquestionably increases the value of property by making streets more desirable and safer for night travel. Any one of our downtown streets can be doubled in business value by the installation of lights. Mark what the '500' block has done."

"In the better illumination of Omaha's streets, uniformity must be the keynote," continues the committee, "and uniformity must govern in the choice of a suitable standard. When it comes to placing these work must be done under the direction of the city engineer, so that proper alignment and spacing will be observed."

NEW DEAN FOR TRINITY PARISH

No Names Submitted and No One Will Be Considered Until Bishop Williams Returns.

"The vestry of Trinity cathedral has not the slightest idea who will be the successor of Dean Beecher," says P. L. Haller, one of the members of the governing body of the parish. "We have been too much stunned," continued Mr. Haller, "by the news, and if there are any favored candidates I have not heard of them, nor have the other members of the vestry with whom I have spoken." When Bishop Williams returns to the city and submits the canonical list of five names, discussion may center upon one or two men, but as yet there is practically no discussion at all."

Henry W. Yates, senior warden of the vestry, said Thursday that he thinks Bishop Williams will submit the list almost immediately upon his return from New York, where the prelate is attending a meeting of a missionary board.

The name of Chaplain Percy H. Silver is upon the lips of some members of the parish. Rev. Mr. Silver is now a missionary of the church stationed in Arizona. He was formerly chaplain in the United States army and lived at Lincoln for a number of years.

No Omaha clergyman of the church is likely to be named by Bishop Williams, or so most members of the vestry think. Several bishops of the church have written here suggesting the names of clergymen within their respective dioceses and several members of the parish talk of men whom they have heard or known elsewhere.

The chances are against a new dean being named in a hurry, although it is possible, of course, that the vestry will agree at once on some one of the bishop's nominations.
