TRADING LARGELY SPECULATIVE

Reduction of Discount Rate by Bank of England Proves Surprise, in View of Threatened Money Stringency.

NEW YORK, Jan. 26.—The stock market traveled today in the path which it has followed often in recent weeks, with some showing of spirit in the first hour and little more than a pretense of conducting business during the remainder of the day.

Bank of England was something of a surprise, in view of the threatened stringency in the London money market and the upward course of private discounts during the last fortnight.

International financiers here were encouraged by the recent utterances of a prominent English banker, reflecting a favorable view of present economic conditions in this country.

Bonds were steady. Total sales, par value, \$1,000,000. United States bonds were unchanged on call.
