CUMMINS FOR THE AGREEMENT

Iowa Senator Speaks for Reciprocity Before Union League Club. SAYS ATTITUDE NEVER IN DOUBT Progressive Leader Asserts Additions Should Be Made to Free List and Declares Canada's Consent Is Unnecessary.

NEW YORK, Feb. 11.—Senator Albert B. Cummins of Iowa spoke in advocacy of the Canadian reciprocity agreement before the Union League of the Brooklyn tonight. Commenting upon the fact that some curiosity had been expressed as to what was his position would be upon the proposed trade agreement, the senator said that it seemed strange to him that after having advanced Canadian reciprocity in every part of the country for ten years, it was now being questioned.

Will Not Affect Farmers. "I am not one of those who believe that the free admission of agricultural products into the United States from Canada will materially affect our farmers, but I do believe that while we are admitting free the things which the farmer sells we should also admit free some of the things the farmer buys."

Unnecessary to Ask Canada. "It is not necessary to ask Canada to agree to these additions to our free list, for they will not be reciprocally free and we put them upon our free list solely for our own good and to equalize among our own people both the advantages and disadvantages of the treaty."
