POSTAL BANK REGULATIONS. Draft of the Rules Which Will Govern the System. INFORMATION FOR SAVING PEOPLE. What may be required for the purchase of money orders are applicable to the acceptance of postal savings deposits, subject to the provisions of section 24 hereof. Sec. 1. Every postoffice designated as a postal savings postoffice will receive deposits for the receipt and withdrawal of deposits every week day during the hours provided for the transaction of postal business and at such other times as the business of the office may justify or as the postmaster directs, with the approval of the board of trustees, shall direct. Sec. 2. An account may be opened and deposits made by any person of the age of 16 years or over, in his or her own name, and by a married woman in her own name and for her husband, but no person may at the same time have more than one such account. Sec. 3. No account may be opened for less than one dollar, nor will fractions of a dollar be accepted for deposit at any time. Sec. 4. No person will be permitted to deposit more than one hundred dollars in any one calendar month, nor will the balance to the credit of any depositor be allowed to exceed five hundred dollars, exclusive of accumulated interest.
