Ceremonies of North Presbyterian Church Will Be Laid Sunday.

## ADDRESS BY DR. CHARLES HERREN

Appropriate Ceremonies Will Be Conducted by Congregation, with Prayers and Talks by Well Known Divines.

The congregation of the North Presbyterian church will lay the cornerstone of its new building at Twenty-fourth and Wirt streets Sunday afternoon at 1 o'clock.

Dr. Charles Herren of the Presbiterian Theological seminary will make a brief address. Daniel E. Jenkins, D. D., of the seminary will offer prayer and the regular quartet of the church will lead the singing. Dr. M. V. Hayes, D. D., the pastor, will have charge of the services.

The stone was furnished and lettered by J. E. Bloom and bears on the Twenty-fourth street side the inscription, "North Presbyterian, 1911." On the Wirt street side is the following inscription, "Jesus Christ Himself Being the Chief Cornerstone." Each face of the stone is 22x22 inches.

On account of the great interest in the evangelistic services at the Calvary Baptist church the Sunday evening services for some time will be made thoroughly evangelistic. The large chorus choir which assisted during the meetings will be continued. A number of the recent converts will receive baptism at the evening service. The pastor's theme for Sunday evening will be "Prisoners of Hope."
