

# Rourkes Beat Antelopes by 2-1; Cubs Shade Giants; Cubs Shade the Phillies; City Hall Wins Ball Game

## ROURKES WALLOP ANTELOPES

Two Wins and a Seventeen-Inning Tie Record of Series.

## OMAHA PLAYS GLASSY BALL

Lincoln Tries for an Eighth Inning Rally When Rourkes Goes Up in Air, But the Sport Falls Short.

Before the largest crowd since the opening game of the season the Rourkes took the third and last game of the series from Lincoln by a score of 2 to 1. Until the eighth inning Omaha played errorless ball and the score was the best seen on the home grounds this year. Three boots and a sacrifice fly gave Lincoln its only run in the eighth.

Rhodes did the twisting for the Rourkes until he was relieved by Hall in the middle of the sixth after allowing seven hits. However, the wife ones were well scattered and by brilliant playing and stellar fielding no damage was done. Hall proved a mystery to the Antelopes, as he did in the first game of the series, and for the remainder of the process held the boys from the capital hitless.

The weather conditions were perfect for base ball and the memory of the seventeen-inning game played the day before brought the fans out in droves. Long before the game was called the crowds began to stream into the bleachers and grandstands and it looked like a capacity house. The box office reports showed the attendance to be 5,000.

Arbogast played a game behind the bat which will not be forgotten by many for a long time. Five men attempted to steal, but only one managed to get away with it. King also played some game in the middle field and one of his catches was of the hair-raising class. Running almost to second he speared a drive just a few inches above the ground. He got the ball, did a few more around the bases and arose to meet a thump of applause from the stands.

Painting put up a classy article of flinging, and although he used but one strike of ball he held the Rourkes to four hits, two of which went to Kane. At no stage of the game did he let up and but for an error of Dundon in the second inning the outcome might have been different. Niehoff brought in a run in the second with a beautiful sacrifice fly to Cobb.

The eighth inning was the only blotch in a perfect game for the Rourkes. That the fans are with the purks was exhibited by the turnout and the hearty support given yesterday.

Neither team managed to get a man as far as second in the first inning. In the second the Antelopes were reduced in one, two, three order. Schoonover drew free transportation in the second. King drove one to Dundon, who muffed it, and then made a poor throw. Schoonover went to third on the error and King got to second. A sacrifice fly by Niehoff brought Schoonover home. King then drew a Texas leaguer to short and King tore home with the second and last run for the Antelopes.

All the way to the eighth Lincoln looked out to the fielders or died on bases. But in the eighth Ungaub got to first on a wild throw by Rhodes. He flew out to Williams and Ungaub stole second, when Arbogast dropped the ball McCormick drove a grass cutter to Kneaves, who tumbled it, the big left fielder reaching first safely. Dundon sent a high fly to Schoonover and Chicago won largely with the first and last run for Lincoln. Score:
