Lord Kitchener Likely to Be Offered a High Post, Which He Will Not Accept, as Offending His Dignity.

LONDON, June 24.—(Special to The Bee.)—Divorce is on the increase throughout this kingdom except in Ireland, where divorce is practically unknown. In a single week Judge Deane granted divorces to 100 couples in this city.

Admiral Sir Percy Scott, who had charge of the naval brigade at the siege of Ladysmith, was granted a divorce recently on account of the misconduct of his wife with Dr. Philip Green. The marriage was not a happy one. Early in 1910 differences arose between husband and wife in reference to her friendship for Dr. Green. The police consulted the admiral's acquaintance to cease, but Lady Scott refused. The result was that there was a deed of separation in 1910, the petitioner allowing his wife \$4,000 a year, which was in addition to her own private fortune. At the end of 1910 the petitioner, in consequence of something he heard, consulted his solicitor. Admiral Scott will have custody of the children.

Crooks are plentiful. Confidence trick swindlers are at present numbering and Scotland Yard officers are taking special measures against them. Gangs have lately arrived from the United States. The principal haunts of these crooks are the larger West End hotels, the various exhibitions and all the principal resorts where wealthy visitors congregate. They have already begun operations, and for some days past complaints have reached the police authorities.

One of the latest arrivals is a wealthy Anglo-Indian tea planter staying at a select hotel in the West End. He has been swindled by two "confidence" men out of a big sum of money and by methods that a village crook would use in starting out on a career as a confidence man.

He was told his name would be enough, and one sum of \$500 was offered him across the table, followed immediately by other promises of help and support of at least two newspapers. Still, he hesitated, repeating, "I should not like to fail."

At last, one of the company said: "Well, Lord Kitchener, if you had doubted about your campaign, perhaps you do not doubt this, you would never have got to Khartoum."

"Perhaps not," said he, "but then I had myself to depend on; now I have got the British people."

Converts to Catholicism. Lord Alfred Douglas was last week received into the Catholic church in the private chapel of the Manor house, Wiltshire, Gunner, by Monsignor Bickerstaffe Drew, and has received confirmation from the bishop of Clifton.

Move for Home Trade. S. M. Hildner, one of the merchants who was active in the "All British" shopping week when all goods of foreign make were tabooed, favors a continuance of the policy as a general proposition. The lord mayor backs him up, saying:

"When I rose this morning I left behind me Irish linen sheets and Whitney blankets and I went into a bath room and washed by the aid of English soap and Irish towels."

Women and Babies Sold in the Streets

Soldiers of the Sultan Perpetrate Dastardly Outrage on Prisoners Brought to Fez.

TANGIER, June 24.—(Special to The Bee.)—Women and babies have been sold publicly in the streets of Fez. On the day after the arrival of the French relief force the soldiers, commanded by European instructors, set forth to punish the Guled Dhamah tribe, whose territory reaches to Fez. From Fez all the tribes' villages could be seen burning, and in the afternoon the soldiers returned with a large number of young women, little girls and some babies. All these the soldiers sold publicly.

A pretty young married woman fetched \$3 and the babies only \$1.50 each. It was a pitiful sight and has had a deplorable effect on the townpeople, the more so as most of the women burned belong to Fez and have remained loyal to the sultan. They are rewarded by having their names burned, the men killed and the women—4 children sold in the streets of Fez.

BERLIN, June 24.—(Special to The Bee.)—After all there may be a royal union between England and Germany. Is the outcome of the Kaiser's visit to be the engagement of the prince of Wales to his daughter, Princess Victoria Louise? The difference of age, one or two years, is not incompatible with prolonged happiness when the pair have such long lives ahead. The fact of the Kaiser inviting the prince to come here for his first foreign visit gives color to all gossip. On the other hand, there can be no question that the two young people were not particularly thrown together. At the military tournament they were seated at opposite ends of the box.

Beginning with the naval review at Spithead today, these coronation receptions and festivities keep the king and queen moving throughout the kingdom.

The royal visit to Ireland from July 7 to 12, the investiture of the prince of Wales at Carnarvon on July 12 and the royal visit to Scotland from July 17 to 21 are some of the principal events.

The program for these various royal functions, beginning with the naval review today, is as follows:

June 24.—Naval review at the Spithead. King and queen spend the night on the royal yacht.

June 25.—Their majesties return to London and attend the gala performance at the Covent Garden opera.

June 27.—Royal garden party at Buckingham palace, followed by a gala performance at His Majesty's theater.

June 28.—The royal guests depart. The king visits the Royal Agricultural show at Norwich.

June 29.—Royal visit to the city of London. Thanksgiving service at St. Paul's cathedral, followed by lunch at the Guild hall. Return journey to the palace through the north London boroughs.

June 30.—King's fête to 10,000 London school children at the Crystal palace. The king and queen will be present at a dinner given by the prime minister and Mrs. Asquith. Coronation medals will be presented to the colonial and Indian troops who have taken part in the ceremony.

July 1.—Their majesties leave for Windsor, alighting at Slough and proceeding by rail to the castle.

July 7 and 8.—Royal visit to Ireland. Arrival at Kingston on board the Victoria and Albert. Landing, and reception by the lord lieutenant; drive to Dublin; opening of the Royal College of Science; visit to Phoenix park; dinner at the castle.

July 9.—Service at St. Patrick's cathedral. Visit to Artisan Industrial school. Inspection of pensioners and girls at Drummond institute.
