John Grant Pegg Asserts Company Offers Free Ice for Nonappearance.

CASE IS PUT OVER FOR A DAY Effort Will Now Be Made to Get the Witnesses to Appear in Police

Court Against the Ice

John Grant Pegg, city inspector of weights, is hot after the Peoples Ice and Coal company because three of his witmesses falled to show up in police court Tuesday when the case against J. Davis, driver of one of the company's wagons, charged with giving short weights, was

called for trial. Davis delivered ice at the Creighton flats. Last Sunday while the inspector of weights was enjoying a chicken dinner at his home he was summoned to the flats to inspect four little chunks of ice that the "leeman" claimed weighed twenty pounds apiece Poss rushed to the place and put the several pieces of ice on the scales before the heat could have a chance to melt them.

Housekeeper Indignant. fints was Mrs. E. C. Dunham, whose twenty-pound plece weighed only eleven. Mrs. J. W. Harney was more fortunate getting good weight as her twentypound cake tipped the scales at twelve and one-half. The real lucky ones were Mrs. J. D. Dorsey and Mrs. Grosso, all tenants in the flats, whose chunks weighed sixteen each. They claimed to have paid the ice-

man for twenty pounds. When Pegg filed information against Davis Monday the driver was arrested by Court Officer Glover. He was released on 319 bends for trial in police court Tuesday morning. All the four complaining women were notified to appear at the hearing Inspector Pegg asserts that late Monday afternoon a representative of the ice company approached the four women and promised to let them have free ice for a whole week providing they refused to prosecute the Iceman. One of the women. whose name he refuses to disclose, notified the inspector of the proposition and said she would be on hand when the case came to trial, provided the other three were compelled to appear. Pegg then had the case continued until Wednesday morning and caused the court to lasue subpoenas for the three rejustant witnesses.
