in Big Cities. WASHINGTON, Sept. 13.-Preliminary figures showing the condition on September of national banks in New York, Boston. St. Louis, Pittsburg and Cincinnati indicate in the aggregate a contraction of loans and discounts, a loss in individual deposits and some contraction of currency. The figures for September 1 are compared with those of June 7, the previous call made by the comptroller of the currency. New York shows loans and other discounts of \$885,500,000, a loss of \$18,000,000; due to other national banks, \$312,000,000, a loss of \$26,000,000; individual deposits, \$706,

Boston shows loans and discounts of \$192,000,000, a loss of \$2,000,000; individual deposits, \$172,000,000, a loss of \$5,500,000. The situation in Pittsburgh, St. Louis and Cincinnati is the reverse. St. Louis shows loans and discounts of \$119,000,000, no change; individual deposits, \$73,500,000, a gain of \$2,500,000. Pittsburgh, shows loans and discounts of \$129,000,000, a gain of \$2,666,600; individual deposits, \$124,660,600. gain of \$2,000,000. Cincinnati shows loans and discounts of \$63,500,000, a gain of \$2,000,000; individual deposits, \$44,500,600, a gain of \$500,000.
