Cable News Still Bearish and Long Sell Heavily. RUN OF CORN IS VERY HEAVY. Rush to Primary Points Has Weakened Values and Changed the Sentiment for the Time Being.

OMAHA, Feb. 17, 1912. All the cable news was bearish again today and longer were heavy sellers trying to save profits and cash wheat was dull and lower. Conservative traders believe it will take a big improved cash demand and a let up in the spring wheat movement to encourage any fresh buying operations.

The run of corn to all primary points has been very heavy all week and this has weakened values and changed sentiment for the time being. Cash corn weakened sharply today and conservative traders concede that some further break is likely.

Wheat opened soft and values were lower on weak cables and continued heavy trade was very moderate. A cash wheat sold for 1.00.

There was an easier feeling in corn in sympathy with wheat and heavy receipts and dull cash demand were features that set values lower. Cash corn was unchanged to 12 cents.
