Killing Cattle Twenty-Five Cents Higher for Week.
HOGS SHOW LITTLE CHANGE
Sheep Close Week Ten to Fifteen Higher Than Last Week, with Lambs Twenty-Five to Sixty Cents Higher.

values were generally quoted anywhere from a quarter to one higher for the week, hogs, lambs getting the long end of the week's business. Demand for both sheep and lambs has been vigorous as a rule, but none of the larger packers have been able to keep killing gangs busy more than two or three hours each day. One concern that ordinarily takes 100,000 head of lambs has killed out only 1,000 head since last week's close. Woolled ewes reached \$2.90 yesterday and attractive lambs were probably taken at \$1.50, but wethers and yearlings have been equally scarce. Quotations on sheep and lambs: Lambs, steady to slow, \$1.60-\$2.00; hogs, fair to good, \$9.00-\$10.00; wethers, fair to good, \$2.50-\$3.00; ewes, fair to good, \$3.00-\$3.50.
