Judge Willis D. Oldham of Kearney is in Omaha today up the supporters of Champ Clark for the presidential nomination of the democratic ticket. The judge believes the Missouriian is a firm conviction that if Colonel Roosevelt were nominated by the republicans Clark would beat him to a frazzle. 'It would be doubtful if President Taft is nominated, for Clark's chances of election would be decreased, but he can beat Roosevelt,' said the judge. 'Why Roosevelt wouldn't carry six states.' Nebraska democrats have gone back on Judge Harmon and Woodrow Wilson never stood a chance, according to Judge Oldham, because he lacks the kind of 'fight' that Roosevelt has.
