RAISE FOR INTERURBAN MEN

New Scale Provides for 20 Cents Hour for Motormen and 24 Cents for Brakemen—Employees Pleased.

DES MOINES, Ia., April 16.—(Special Telegram.)—The Iowa crop reporting bureau resumed weekly reports today for the first time, and the preliminary report shows that conditions are excellent for starting farm work in Iowa this year. The winter wheat acreage is large. Spring work in fields has been commenced in southern counties. There is fear of frost tonight, which might do injury to some fruit buds. Raise for Interurban Men. Fifty employes of the Interurban Railway company will receive a radical raise in wages by virtue of a peaceable agreement. The new scale provides a flat rate of 20 cents an hour for motormen and conductors and 24 cents for brakemen. No overtime is allowed. The Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Railway Trainmen and officials of the railway in secret conference fixed the scale. The employes are vastly pleased over the raise. The former scale was 21 cents to 28 cents an hour in proportion to years of service. Barn Burned at Griswold. WEST LIBERTY, Ia., April 16.—(Special.)—The new barn on the farm of Dr. R. H. Johnson, two miles southwest of Griswold was destroyed by fire Sunday morning. Four head of horses, one of which was a valuable stallion, three calves and thirteen head of hogs, were burned to death.
