Citizens' Union Men Spend More Money Than the Others.

SOME CLOSE TO THE LIMIT

Dozen Candidates Tell What Money They Spent in Effort to Secure Nomination at Recent Primaries for Councilmen.

Endorsees of the Citizens' union spent more money to secure the commission-ership nomination than any other state.

Millard F. Funkhouser blew in \$26 according to his statement. He gave \$25.50 of this to the Citizens' union.

William A. Redick spent \$200 on the Citizens' union, donating it in three batches, the first being given March 28.

By law, candidates must file their expense accounts within ten days after the election.

It is rumored widely that the maximum campaign expense as fixed by law held no power of restraint over candidates.
