#### Cuba to Purchase Rifles and Powder of United States

WASHINGTON June 4 .- The State department today authorized the War department to honor the application of the Cuban government for 5,000 rifles and 1,000,000 rounds of ammunition, which are to be used to arm the volunteers and the guards organized by plantation owners to protect their property against the insurrectos.

President Gomes wanted the latest type of Springfield rifles similar to the 19,000 already supplied to the Cuban army. When it was found that such arms could not be sold without express authority from congress, and as it would take some time to secure the necessary legislation the Cuban government decided to accept Krag-Jorgensen rifles instead. These are practically new weapons. They will be sold to the Cuban government at about \$5 apiece plus express charges.

SANTIAGO, Cuba, June 4-A resolution was presented by Cuban merchants at a meeting of the Chamber of Commerce this afternoon that the government be petitioned to accept the assistance of the United States in order to control the situation on the ground that the present forces are inadequate to do so.

The motion was rejected, but the chamber approved a resolution requesting the government to furnish arms to the owners and employes of stores and shops in the villages around Santiago.

### Speaker in San Diego Ridiculed by Citizens

SAN DIEGO, Cal., June 4 .- Another attempt today to test the city's "move on" ordinance was met in a new way by San Diegoans-the speaker was ridiculed. Raymond Benjamin, chief deputy attorney general, was generally credited with the change in the attitude of the citizens.

L. A. Shiffrin who said he was from Oakland, spoke on the street outside the restricted district today and, although he received considerable jostling by police and citizens, he suffered no violence. Shiffrin said he was there in the interests of no particular organization, but be-
