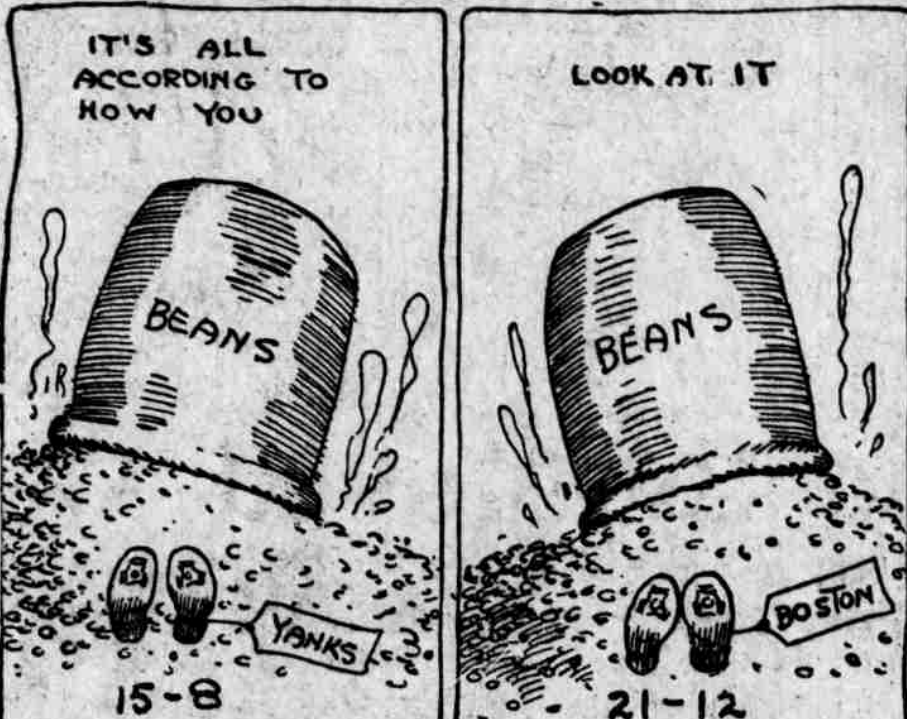

SIOUX TAKE EIGHT STRAIGHT

Up-River, Men Permit Bourkes to Score One Lone Run.

OMAHA MEN KEPT GUESSING

Robinson Starts Well, but Loses Grip When Is Fought for a Home Run.

Sioux City took its eighth straight game from Omaha yesterday, winning the game, 5 to 1. "Red" White kept his hits widely scattered and had Omaha on his hip almost all the while. Robinson, on the other hand, was found almost at will by the wily Indians and a slugger in the sixth gave the visitors three runs. Omaha's crippled lineup played as loose as they have the last three days and although managing to get men on bases could not bring them around. The Bourkes got their only run in the second inning, when Niehoff opened with a double and scored on a triple by Arbogast. White was the big noise and had Omaha going with nothing but a straight ball. He did not let himself out until a man would get to first base and then with apparent ease retired the succeeding batsmen. His form was pretty and he only passed one man. In only one inning did he give more than one hit.

Robinson started out in great shape, but when Tennant landed on the fourth in the fourth inning for a home run, he began to weaken and in the next two innings Andrews' bunch forged ahead and were never in danger of being caught.

Switch the Lineup.

Omaha switched its lineup somewhat by putting Bill Schipke in at second base and sending Scanlon to first. Jim Kane was brought in as a pinch hitter in the ninth and singled. "Hickory" Johnson, Omaha's catcher, who was injured when struck with a ball last week, was run in as a pinch hitter in the ninth, as was also Jack Ryan.

Omaha scored first in the second. Niehoff doubled to left and scored on Arbogast's triple to the right field fence.

The Sioux came back in the fourth and tied up with Tennant's home run over the right field fence.

Cadman drew a walk in the fifth. White was hit with the ball. Millon fouled out to Arbogast. Smith scored Cadman on a single to center.

Tennant opened the sixth with a double to right. An infield hit by Breen placed him on third and he scored on Andrews' single to right. Relly struck out and Breen and Andrews romped home on Cadman's double to center. Score:
