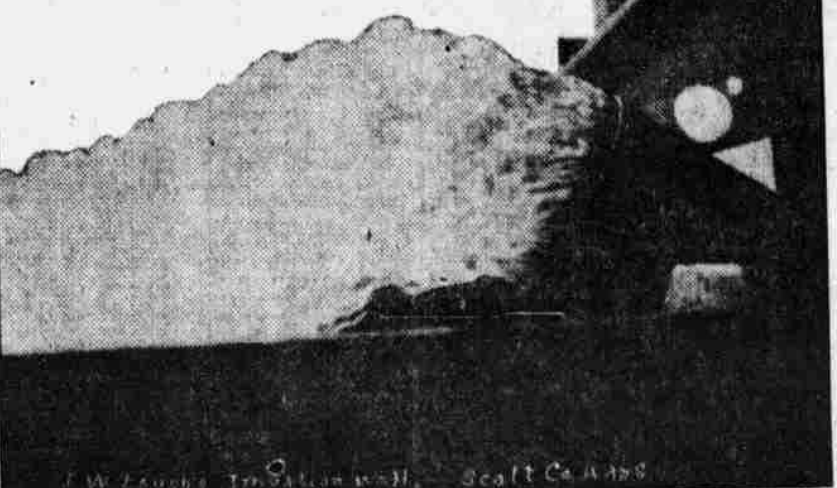

ROOSEVELT ANSWERS BRYAN

Fails to Say How Many Terms He Would Like. WILSON TAUNTS THE COLONEL. Says that Trusts Flourished to Greater Extent During His Administration Than During Any Other.

DENVER, Colo., Sept. 20.—A declaration in favor of the recall of the president was made last night by Colonel Roosevelt. He proposed that if, as president, he found that his views were in opposition to those of the people, he should take the stump in defense of his policies, and should quit office if he could not win the support of the electorate.

Colonel Roosevelt's declaration was made in reply to a question addressed to him by William J. Bryan in a recent speech at Pueblo, Colo. "How many terms," Mr. Bryan asked in a list of queries which he said Colonel Roosevelt should answer, "was the president of the United States served?" Colonel Roosevelt gave his answer in his speech before a crowd which filled the Auditorium.

"As far as I am concerned," he said, "I should be glad to have the recall of the president. It is not in the progressive platform, and this is merely an expression of my personal feeling. My own experience was that I could do nothing as president except when the people were heard with me. The minute I ceased to have them with me, whether it was my fault or theirs, I ceased to have power. Under such conditions I would prefer to leave the presidency, unless in fact, after fighting on the stump I could bring the people around to my way of thinking, such a course, I think, would be to my advantage and to theirs.

Dodges Direct Question. "As to the number of nonconsecutive terms a president might have, every affirmation in favor of any limitation of the terms of the president can refer only to consecutive terms. Any third term talk which refers to 'nonconsecutive terms is an utter absurdity.' "Mr. Bryan professes to believe in the people. It was to the people that I made my appeal, and in the primaries, by voice varying from two to one to fifteen to one, the people decided that the task of a third term in this case was the veriest hoguog ever held up to frighten political children."

One by one Colonel Roosevelt took up Colonel Bryan's questions, five in all. First on the list was: "Will you explain to the people the circumstances connected with the writing of your letter to Mr. Harriman in which you addressed him as 'my dear Mr. Harriman' and called yourself 'both practical men'?" Colonel Roosevelt said that he had already gone over the matter time after time and that Mr. Bryan must know it, and must have seen his recent letter to Senator Chappin in regard to the senate investigation of senate contributions.

"If Mr. Bryan understands words of any available," he said, "he must have understood my letter." In reply to the question: "What is the do you have in your platform that you did not borrow from the democratic platform?" Colonel Roosevelt responded: "All of them."

"Why did you put state issues, such as the initiative and the referendum, in your national platform?" was the next question. Colonel Roosevelt replied that the initiative and the referendum were both national and state issues and were treated as such by the progressive party. The number of terms for a president is a substantive issue. "What is the initiative of George W. Perkins in your campaign?" Colonel Roosevelt replied to this question by saying that he had done before, suggesting that Mr. Perkins had joined the movement because he believed it offered a solution of problems which, in his opinion, must be solved to insure the continued welfare of the people.

Wilson Taunts Colonel. DETROIT, Mich., Sept. 19.—Trusts flourished more under former President Roosevelt's administration than under any other in the history of the country, Wilson was the way Governor Woodrow Wilson replied, in a speech here tonight, to questions of Colonel Roosevelt at Trinidad, Colo., yesterday, taking exception to the democratic nominee's statement that during the trust investigation by the House Messrs. Gary and Perkins suggested the trust plank in the republican platform, proposing a federal commission to regulate the trusts.

Men and Women of Ulster to Sign Pact of Rebellious Tone. BELFAST, Ireland, Sept. 20.—Sir Edward Carson, ex-social approval for the Ulster unionist council the wording of the covenant which Ulster unionists throughout the province will sign September 28. The covenant will be as follows: "Being convinced that home rule would be disastrous to the material well-being of Ulster as well as to the whole of Ireland, subversive to our civil and religious freedom, destructive to our citizenship and perilous to the unity of the empire, we, whose names are underwritten, sign of Ulster, loyal subjects of his gracious majesty, King George V, humbly relying on God, in whom our fathers in days of stress and trial confidently trusted, hereby pledge ourselves in solemn covenant throughout this, our time of threatened calamity, to stand by one another in defending for ourselves and for our children our cherished position of equal citizenship in the United Kingdom; and in using all means which may be found necessary to defeat the present conspiracy to set up home rule in Ireland; and in the event of such parliament being forced upon us, we solemnly and mutually pledge ourselves to refuse to recognize its authority in the sure confidence that God will defend the right."

Probate Judges Opposed to Recall of Court Decisions

CHICAGO, Sept. 19.—Opposition to the recall of judges and of judicial decisions was expressed at the annual convention of the National Association of Probate Judges today.

"Enforce that principle and we will have made the constitution useless," said Joseph C. Talmadge, Catskill, N. Y. "Our courts would be in chaos, for no satisfactory substitute for the present system has been offered by those who advocate recall."

WIDOW OF WAR GOVERNOR REVIEWS THREE REGIMENTS. IOWA CITY, Ia., Sept. 20.—(Special Telegram)—Mrs. Samuel Kirkwood, widow of Iowa's famous war governor, together with General Beane Hoxie, wife of Governor Beane Hoxie, reviewed 200 veterans of the second and Iowa's Twenty-fourth, Twenty-second and Twenty-eighth infantry, as a close to an eastern Iowa reunion here this afternoon.
