Peter Loch to Help Charity Working. Tourney to Help Fanily Welfare. PROCEEDS FOR THIS PURPOSE. Loch Will Pay Auditorium Rent and Bear All Other Expense—To Secure Holiday Fund for the Poor.

A fund will be raised for the City mission with a wrestling tournament which will be held some time during the two weeks preceding Christmas. Peter Loch, who has promoted several athletic events as business propositions, will provide all the expenses of the tournament, and the entire proceeds will be turned over to Miss Nellie Magee, superintendent of the mission.

Formulation of plans for the tournament was begun by Mr. Loch yesterday afternoon. About five wrestling bouts will be the principal feature. Between them music will be dispensed by an orchestra. Mr. Loch will pay the rental of the Auditorium for the night. He will provide the wrestlers and put on the purses for them. All expenses will be borne by him personally and will not be taken out of the receipts. All these will go to the mission.

The price of tickets probably will be \$1. Whether seats will be reserved has not been determined. Mr. Loch will have charge of the entire sale of the venture. The receipts, which will be in charge of a committee of three newspaper men, one from each of the Omaha daily papers, Edward Black, Miles Greenleaf and VanVechten Howter.
