Supreme Court Holds that Commerce Commission Has Jurisdiction.

PAYMENT TO PACKER IS REBATE

Commissioner's Suit to Have Annulled Contract Locating Plant Near Tracks Is Upheld by the Highest Tribunal.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 9.—Jurisdiction of an action in the commerce court to enjoin the Interstate Commerce commission over the Union Stock Yard and Transit company of Chicago was today upheld by the supreme court, which sustained the commission's right to bring suit to have annulled a contract to pay \$90,000 to Packer & Sons, packers, for erecting a plant adjacent to its tracks.
