TO DEMAND PROMISE BE KEPT

Business Men to Insist on Hill Building Connecting Line.

OMAHA THOROUGHLY AROUSED
Freight Solicitors for the Burlington
are Having a Hard Time
Now in Securing Business
for That Road.

The effect of the Burlington moving its auditing and claim departments from Omaha to Chicago promises to bring to that company other results than the loss of business. It means that the business men and business interests of the city are going to demand that the Hill people make good their promises of years ago and build the Ashland cut-off into this city.

Omaha business men were thoroughly aroused several days ago, when The Bee gave to the public the exclusive information that the Burlington was preparing to move to Chicago the departments of the Omaha headquarters, but they took no action, hoping that the officials would change their minds. Now, having read through The Bee the statement of President Miller that the change is not only contemplated, but actually ordered, they are prepared to take action.

While Omaha has no claim that it is ordered to support the Burlington freight solicitors are having considerable

difficulty in securing business to points reached by other lines. Firms and corporations that have been doing business with the Burlington for years are now informing freight solicitors and officials that the relations have been severed and that their shipments are being routed over other lines.

As to the Ashland cut-off, when it was built by Hill several years ago an effort was made to induce him to build into this city. He informed the delegations that called upon him that this would be impracticable, but that a branch from some point on the same would be constructed into this city, giving Omaha and Omaha business the benefit of the through line. Up to this time, say business men, no move has been made upon the part of Hill or the Hill interests to keep the promise solemnly made.

Now Omaha business men believe the time is ripe to strike and, united upon the proposition, they will give the Hill interests to understand that if they are to get any more business out of this city—east or west, north or south—this line must be built, and without needless delay. The business men of this city agree that they do not expect to wreck the Hill system of roads, but they feel that if they unite they can control enough shipments to make their influence felt, especially when the roads come to declaring dividends.

County Prisoner is Believed Insane

Deputy County Attorney Magney will investigate a statement of Charles Leonard, a county jail prisoner, charged with carrying concealed weapons, who asserts

that he has lost \$4.50 and a diamond ring since his incarceration. The jail authorities think Leonard's story is untrue and that the man is insane. Examiner Tilden of the insanity commission has examined the man and doubts his sanity. Further examination will be made.

Leonard was arraigned before Judge Sutton. When asked to plead to the

charge he said he had carried a concealed revolver, but did so because Union Pacific strike breakers had threatened his life for refusing to walk out with them. He said he did not agree with them because they wanted to run the railroad.

He stated that when he was transferred from the city to the county jail he had \$65, a watch and chain and a diamond

ring worth \$50, but now the jail authorities tell him he has only 50 cents. Leonard spoke rationally, but his appearance was strange and deputy sheriffs say he never tells the same story twice.

Dependent Woman Puzzles Association

She was sent to Park Wilde Home, where she will be cared for until some relative or person who knows something about her is located.

Secretary Porter has written Minnesota charitable organizations, believing that they sent the woman here to secure her maintenance by the Omaha charities.
