

Nebraska WATER BOARD BILL IS IN Measure to Place Supervision of the Omaha Plant Under Commission. SIX MEMBERS SIGN NAMES

Yates of Douglas Introduces Draught Measure Governing Running of Autos and Providing for Competent Handling.

(From a Staff Correspondent.) LINCOLN, Neb., Jan. 27.—(Special Telegram.) The bill to abolish the water board of Omaha and place the supervision of the water plant under the control of the city commission was introduced in the house this afternoon by six members of the Douglas delegation—Anderson, Flanagan, Hoff, Yates, Simon and Smith.

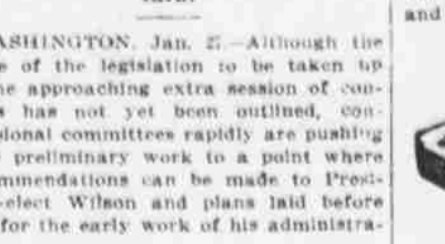
