

SEES GROWTH FOR OMAHA

Industrial Commissioner of Missouri Pacific is Impressed. TO IMPROVE THE BELT LINE Says His Company Will Do Everything Possible to Induce Manufacturing Concerns to Locate in Omaha.

"Watch Omaha Grow." That is the slogan that has been adopted by D. E. King, industrial commissioner of the Missouri Pacific Railroad company, who is in town and will remain until Saturday.

Speaking of Omaha, Commissioner King said: "Business and industrial conditions throughout the entire country are good, but nowhere better than in Omaha. Very few of the cities are forging ahead as is this one, and none has a brighter future."

"We are not making any boasts of what we are going to do, but I want to say that unless people get their property too high out there we are going to build up a great industrial center along the Belt Line. We are going to continue this work until every piece of property along the line is occupied by a manufacturing or commercial plant."

"Omaha is attracting much more notice than those living here realize. At our St. Louis offices we are receiving many inquiries concerning Omaha and the opportunities for investment, and while we are not looking for any boom here we are looking for a growth that has been unprecedented."
