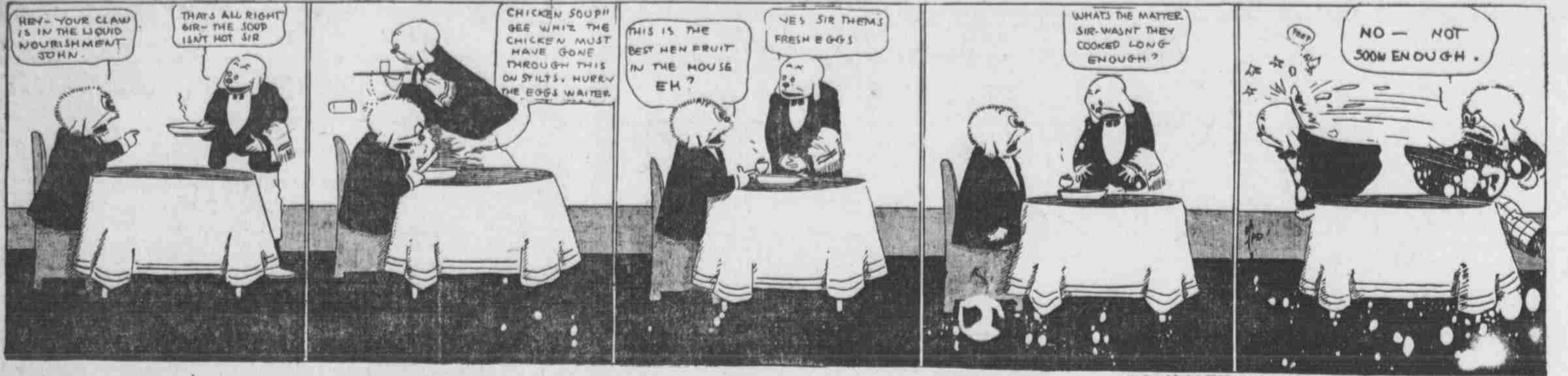


Silk Hat Harry's Divorce Suit--A Polite Waiter and Some Ancient Hen Food.
