Kansas City Grain and Provisions—

Features of the Trading and Closing Prices on Board of Trade.

CHICAGO, Sept. 22.—Visible supply figures very close to \$0,000,000 bushels, as against \$0,000,000 a year ago acted as a weight today on wheat. The market finished nervous at 70¢ decline. Corn came up with a gain of 1½¢ to 64¢/bushel, oats off 1½¢ and provisions dearer by 5¢/bushel.

Besides the increase in the United States visible supply an enlargement of Canadian visible supply had the effect of swamping the wheat trade. Wheat in the northwest reported a mountain of receipts appeared to be rolling up and that a big portion might have to be held in Chicago stocks. On the information basis leaders here predicted the selling to such an extent that many stop-loss orders came into play.

Fear that frosts had caused more damage than popularly supposed, notwithstanding weakness early in sympathy with wheat. Most of Iowa and parts of Illinois were affected by the freezing weather of last night.

On grain company with corn and followed wheat. The visible supply was reported as the largest on record, \$0,000,000 bushels, against 878,000 bushels a year ago.

Frosty weather and higher prices for hogs lifted provisions. There was a fairly important increase of investment buying, chiefly of delivered deliveries.
