NEW YORK STOCK MARKET.

Absence of Absorptive Power Most Obvious Characteristic. TRADING IS UNUSUALLY LIGHT. Recent Advances from Mexico Influential in Restricting Speculation-Bond Market is Steady.

NEW YORK, Oct. 25.-The small fluctuations in stocks which occurred today gave no indication of the trend of the speculative sentiment. The most obvious characteristic of the market was the absence of absorptive power. Trading was unusually light, but the small offerings made were sufficient to depress prices generally.

The customary week end closing late in the afternoon was a flight of the market which restored the list to about a parity with yesterday's final range. There was a general feeling of uncertainty as to what developments of the next few days, as was shown by the lack of initiative on either side of the market.

Recent advances from Mexico in particular were influential in restricting speculation. Estimates of the expected influence of the United States Steel corporation in its forthcoming quarterly statement were optimistic and the expected influence of this report tended to ward off further attacks from the bears at this time.
