> Secretary of State Has Peace Plans, While Navy and War Departments Continually Over-

ride Them.

(From a Staff Correspondent.)

WASHINGTON, April 22,-(Special Telegram.)-Representative Barton, who introduced on June 2, 1913, a resolution for the election of a committee to provide government armor plants for the manufacture of armor plate, today addressed the house while the naval appropriation bill was under discussion, reciting in the course of his remarks the entire history of armor plate manufacture from the besinning of an armor plate factory in the United States.


He showed how the Carnegie Steel company had been benefited. He recited how the government was at the marcy of the cowder trust until it went into the powder manufacturing business for itself, and by analogy wanted the government to go into the manufacture of armor plate. He deplored the war that seems to be upon us and which looks as if we were going

into Mexico to stay.

"We are military mad, each nation to outdo the other." said he in speaking about the amount of money carried in the naval appropriation bill for battleships and other instrumentalities of naval war-"And if this continues the only fare. result can be absorption of the nation's wealth into machines of war that will soon disintegrate, leaving a bankrupt 640, Bee, Omaha.
