May Wheat Shorts Are in Dilemma Over Situation. WHEAT FAVORING THE BULLS Reports are to the effect that there are decreases in nearly all of the routine statistical supplies.

OMAHA, Neb., April 28, 1914. May wheat shorts are in a dilemma. The opening in that month on the Chicago Board of Trade is much larger than the average speculator knows and the controlling interest in that future controls the cash wheat of Chicago as well. These conditions leave the shorts at the mercy of the bulls, who are confident that should be available it is closed off. Because of these conditions there is a leaning on the part of many in the trade to make another attempt to change the rules of the board so that deliveries on contracts may be made on the tracks.

At Liverpool wheat closed 1/4 cent lower. Primary wheat receipts were 240,000 bu. and shipments 230,000 bu. against receipts of 1,800,000 bu. and shipments of 1,700,000 bu. last year.
