Other Staple Products Also Go Up, Garden Stuff Remaining Same.

SUGAR COSTS MORE WHOLESALE And Over Retail Counter Twenty Pounds Are Now Weighed Out

for One Dollar Instead

of Twenty-Three.

A general advance was seen in the prices of meats during the week, as well as in several other staple products. Practically everything has suffered an adance except green stuff, as the grocers all it. Radiahes, onions, cucambers and various products from the garden and

o abundant as to be very cheap. Lambs jumped 11 a hundred pounds. the packing houses have cut down the rders from their own branch houses because they could not fill them all. Those retailing at 12% cents a week ago are now retailing at 14% cents, and the higher grades have correspondingly increased. Light beef is cheaper, and the heavier

beef is a trifle cheaper. Smoked mests have advanced 50 cents per hundred weight wholesale. That is considered a normal advance in smoked neats for this time of the year. Veal has advanced \$2 per hundred, for

the first-class stuff. Veal steaks are retailing at 30 and 35 cents. Round steak has advanced a dollar a

hundred wholesale, and will soon be selling at 27% cents a pound retail. These are prices paid only for sirioin a few Years ago.

Even beef liver is now wholesaling at 0 cents a pound, and this a few years ago was thrown over the counter to the town dogs and kitchen cats. Calf liver is wholesaling at 22 cents a pound. Sugar has jumped 50 cents a sack whole-

sale. It is now sold twenty pounds for a dollar, while it was sold twenty-three for a dollar a week ago. It is predicted that it will go higher yet in a short time, ac cording to Al King, of the grocery department at Hayden Bros.

Flour has advanced 25 cents a barrel, r 614 cents a sack. This is a wholesale quotation. This will advance it 10 cents a sack retail.

In the green garden produce the prices are somewhat easier. Radishes are selling eight bunches for a nickel and onions six bunches for a nickel. Fancy large cucumbers that sold at 20 cents a dozen a week ago, are now selling at 20 cents. Asparagus is holding its own at 5 cents
