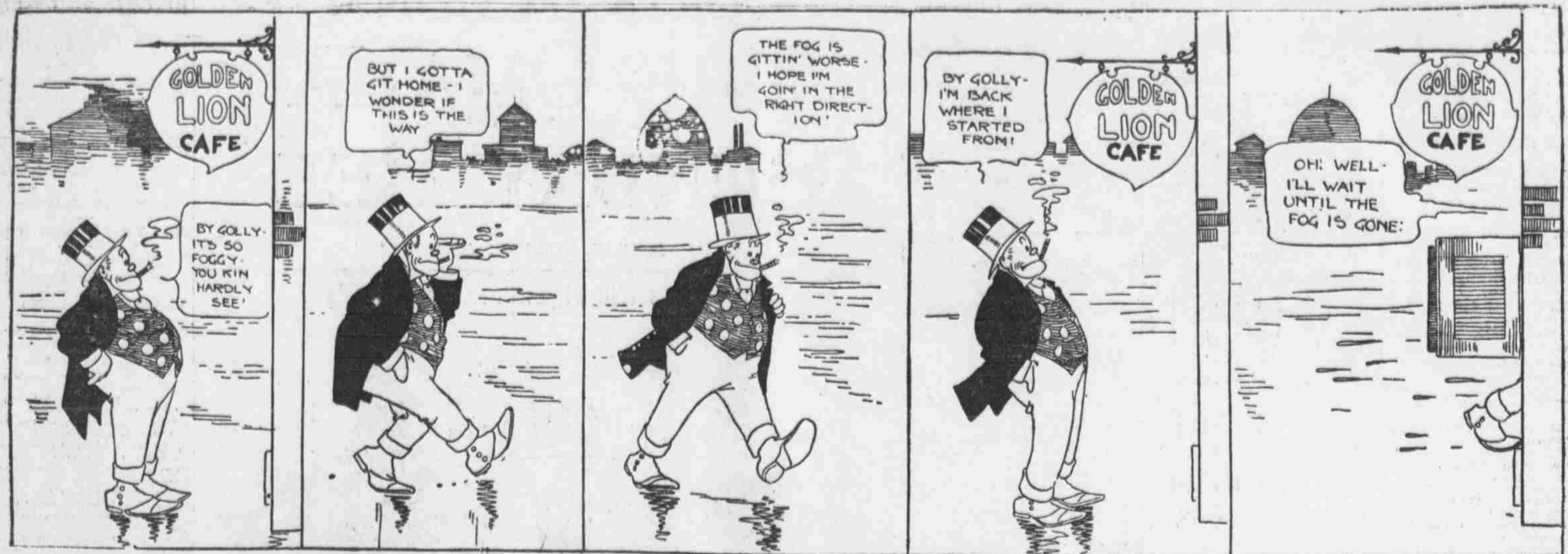

BURNS LEADS IN THE NATIONAL

Le Jeune of Sioux City Continues at High Place in Western League

CHICAGO, July 3.—Ty Cobb's idleness, forced on him by a broken thumb, while his rivals slumped, put him in first place among the batters of the American league, according to averages published here today. His percentage is 33. The next nine batters in the American league are: C. Walker, St. Louis, .342; Baker, Philadelphia, .329; Crawford, Detroit, .324; Jackson, Cleveland, .323; E. Collins, Philadelphia, .314; Speaker, Boston, .311; Lelievre, Cleveland, .297; Wood, Cleveland, .291; Moran, Washington, .289. The Athletics lead in club batting with .291 and Detroit is second with .246. Maisei of New York leads in stolen bases with twenty-seven. Ranked according to games won and lost, Plank, Philadelphia, with eight and two; Leonard, Boston, with ten and three; and Pennock, Philadelphia, and Wood, Boston, with three and one each, lead the pitchers.
