

BLACK SHEEP CLAMORING

School Board Members Want Citizens' Committee Endorsement.

RUSMISEL CASE AT ISSUE

Candidates Attempt to Stir Up Sentiment in Their Own Behalf by Attacking Record of the Board of Education.

A committee of citizens effected to pass upon the eligibility of candidates for the Board of Education and select and draft candidates, if necessary, is being besieged with clamors for endorsement by certain school board members who are basing their chief claim for recognition upon the fact that they are opposed to Principal L. C. Rusmiser of the Omaha High School of Commerce.

This committee met one night this week in the office of Attorney Halleck Rose. President C. T. Walker of the Board of Education was present by request. Member C. V. Warfield was also there. An attempt was made to secure the endorsement of Warfield's and A. J. Burdick's candidacy, but only two candidates were endorsed as far as is known—Robert Cowell and Dr. F. J. Swoboda.

Mr. Burdick, fifth ward member of the school board, who has been severely criticized for acting as the cat's paw of real estate men who attempted to put something over on the board, let it be known that he was against the board's action in dismissing or demoting certain teachers for insubordination in connection with the Rusmiser case and sought favor by this means.

One of the teachers, Miss Louise Stegner, who asserts she was dismissed because she testified against Mr. Rusmiser, has stirred up some of the candidates by announcing that she has filed formal notice with the board that she is ready to perform her contract to teach. This matter as well as the dismissal of Prof. Bernstein of the Omaha High school, is being investigated by the committee.

Whether this committee will get behind some of the discredited members of the board, support only a few candidates or announce a complete slate of eight candidates and support them as a unit is a problem unsolved.

Some members of the committee who met Tuesday night in Mr. Rose's office are: Robert Smith, clerk of the district court; Mr. and Mrs. James Richardson; Mrs. Halleck Rose and Mr. Rose; W. F. Baxter; Miss Kate McHugh, former principal of the Omaha High school; David Cole; C. V. Warfield and C. T. Walker. Mr. Baxter acted as chairman of the meeting.

Two New Cases of Diphtheria Reported

Two new cases of diphtheria among school children have been reported to the city health office, one from Bancroft school. The health commissioner has ordered investigation and thorough fumigation to prevent contagion.

"The school board should have heeded my letter; children should have been examined at the beginning of school," said Health Commissioner R. W. Connell. "We are now fighting the problem of preventing a contagion."

The two deaths reported from diphtheria this week are said by physicians to have been caused by the disease in a most virulent form.

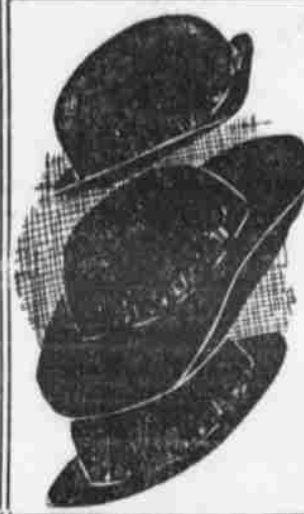
