

services of W. L. MacKenzie King. EL PASO, Tex., Oct. 1 .- Further definite reports of divisions in Villa's army reached the border today from both official and impartial sources. The report that General Monclovio Herrera, with his entire brigade, had revolted against Villa's authority was confirmed. It also was reported that the Arrieta brothers, leaders in Durango, had revolted to the Carranza side, and that Villa's leader, Tomas Urbina, had taken Durango City after a battle.
