## TWO GREAT FRAYS IN WEST

Illini-Badger and Husker-Hawkeye Games Headliners Today.

## MAROONS AND GOPHERS PLAY

Nebraska's Claim for Western Championship to Look Weak or Strong According to Outcome at Iowa City.

Western foot ball, so far as its chief exponent is concerned, will end its season tomorrow. Of the half dozen games of importance on the card, the Illinois-Wisconsin and the Nebraska-Iowa contests stand out as having bearing on championship claims, while because of traditions surrounding them there will be widespread interest in the Chicago-Minnesota, Kansas-Missouri and Indiana-Purdue games.

In the Badgers, Illinois meets the last obstacle in its path to the championship of the conference. A clean slate against both weak and the strong is the boast of the Illini to date and on performances they should beat Wisconsin tomorrow and earn a clear title to leading honors of the Big Nine. They have beaten Minnesota, which trounced Wisconsin, and Chicago, which played a tie game with the Badgers.

The Cornhuskers, aside from the tie game with South Dakota very early in the season, have been uniformly successful, taking beyond question the highest honors in the Missouri valley. Of course, their game with Iowa will not settle definitely their standing, but comparison of the Missouri valley game with that of the conference, so far as tomorrow's contest makes them possible, should be interesting for viewers.

With the odds on their side in nearly every point of the game, the Minnesotans tackle Chicago tomorrow, favorites by a slight margin. Coach Staggs will oppose to the onslaught of the northerners only the wreck of the team that defended gallantly this season the title won last year.

## BRESNAHAN PLANNING A SERIES OF TRADES
