Chiefly of interest in "The Wishing Ring" are scenes taken in the blue room of Arlena Towers and showing a magnifficent statue of Diana, one of Mr Brandels' art possessions. It is thought that "The Wishing Ring" will be produced in Omaha in the near future.

Musical America has a scheme for the registration of music teachers, which demands that when a musician makes application for a license he must accompany the same with a statement of his qualifications, and that he shall swear to this before a notary public. This bill also provides for penalties for making false statements and provides that a copy of the original application must be obtained, displayed in every studio, and that a copy of the same may be obtained by any one for a small fee. This is offered instead of a system of examinations which are agitating many of the state legislatures at present.
