## Change in National **Base Ball Agreement**

UINCINNATI, Dec. IL .- Section 1, acticle II of the National base ball agreement. has been amended by the concurrent vote of each major league and of the National association by increasing the membership of the joint committee on playing rules to seven members, according to a national mission notice issued today. Ar amended and effective from today or this section and article, will read as follows:

Whenever the commission certifies to the president of each major league and to the secretary of the National association that in its judgment the playing rules require amendment, a joint comission from each major league and one opresentative of the National association shall meet on or before October of the year in which such notice is served, and adopt a code of rules for the ensuing season.
