Record-Breaking Dullness Attends

First Session of Year. UNDERTONE BARELY STEADY

Only 25,000 Shares Traded to Some of the Prominent Innece Failing to Make an Appenyappe of All.

NEW YORK, Jan. 2.—Record breaking duliness attended the opening of the new year on the stock exchange. In the course of today's two-hour session only 23.586 shares were traded in, some of the prominent issues failing to appear at all. The undertone of leading stocks was barely steady after opening with general declines.

The only notable changes were in some of the inactive specialties, Sears-Rosbuck gaining five points, with a six-point loss for New York Airbrake. Shares of sev-

gaining five points, with a six-peint loss for New York Airbrake. Shares of soveral of the automobile companies added to recent gains, while the Gould stocks showed more firmness.

Completion of the detail connected with the fla,000,000 boan by the local banking interests to Argentina, was included in the small budget of general news, and rumors of further toans to cetablish credits at this center for some of the European governments were revived.

Sentiment regarding the outlook in London, where market operations of a restricted character are to be remewed next Monday, was chilled by the latest diameter to the British navy. London hankers, according to private cables, were arrancing for the purchase of 250,000,000 france 8 per cent French treasury bills. These same advices suggested payment by Russia to Paris.

Home news included full time resumptions on operations at the sheeps of the Bouthern Pacific and Northern Pacific rallroads and more November rallway returns, the Pennsylvania road showing a net loss of about \$450,000 for its eastern lines and \$250,000 on that part of the system west of Pittsburgh.




