Outstanding Feature of Dull and Irregular Session Its Extremely Professional Character.

BETTER FEELING IN STEEL

NEW YORK, Feb. 3.—The outstanding feature of today's dull and irregular market was its extremely professional character. Trading was almost given over to that faction, which continued its operations on the bear side, judging from the quiet but persistent pressure upon the leading issues for the greater part of

the seasion.

United States Steel, which led yesterday's rise, kept well above its new minimum, most of the selling concentrating upon Reading and Casadian-Pacific.

These stocks, particularity Reading, showed some heaviness in the London market, where the international list, with few exceptions, tended toward a lower level. Selling for foreign account here was not sufficiently large to affect quoted values.

was not sufficiently large to affect quoted values.

There were some contrary movements in the industrial and special groups, Petroleum shares adding to recent gains on reports of another advance in the price of the crude product. Fertilizer issues also scored substantial advances, while the sugar stocks declined precipitately during mid-session. Closing prices in many instances were below yesterday's, National Biscuit and Missouri Pacific developing sudden weakness.

Careal markets attracted less attention, although May wheat once more moved in sensational fashion, suffering a severe decline at the close. Commission houses with local connections reported a decrease in wheat operations for New York account. Unofficial advices suggested a continuance of the large foreign demand for our foodstuffs and cotton.

Trade authorities report a better feeling this week in the steel industry, the more important companies expecting a further increase running into March. This is evidenced in the additions recently made to the working forces in the Pittaburgh and Cleveland districts.

The nature of the bond market, which reflected the contraction in stocks, was the introduction into the board of the new Pennsylvania 4½ per cents, which would at their recent high price. Otherwise the price movement was irregular. Total sales, par value, aggregated \$1,89,-100. United States bonds were unchanged on call, but the 2s and 4s gained on achief transactions.
