GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET
Wheat Selling at Five Cents Lower Leads Corn and Oats Down in Price.

OMAHA RECEIPTS ARE LIGHT
OMAHA, February 23, 1915.
The receipts of wheat, corn and oats are very light in the local market. A year ago today there was a total of over 500 cars received, while today the total receipts were only 171 cars. Chicago led approximately 100 cars. The May option on wheat was 2 1/2c under Saturday's closing price, and gradually went down to the 1 1/2c level. Although the market was very light, there was very little demand for either wheat, corn or oats in the local cash market, and all of these grains sold considerably under the closing prices of the previous day.

The wheat leading to the primary markets are out of order and it is impossible to procure any information as to receipts from the primary markets. Cash wheat was 4 1/2c lower. Cash corn was 1 1/2c lower.
