S-room street, 4 CHICAGO, March 17.—Splendid crop promise on a big acreage had much to do today with lowering the wheat market here. Values were unsettled at the close, which was %63½ under last night. Other articles too showed net declines, corn. 61467½ cents; oats, ½6½ cents to 5½ cents, and provisions, 7½7½ cents to 5½ cents. Magnificent was the term used by one expert in describing the outlook for the Illinois winter crop. He had just completed an inspection that extended from Chicago to Cairo. Recent rains over the fall sown belt in other states were said by a different authority to have made conditions unusually favorable for early spring growth. Scattering reports of the plant not wintering well were declared to be less numerous that has been customary.

be less numerous that has been customary.

Bearish cable news and slackness of export call tended to discourage wheat buyers even before prices came noticeably under the shadow of the new crop. Anglo-French progress in the Dardanelles, reported illness of the kaiser, and the prospect of more liberal shipments from Argentina were all elements in the feeling against the built side. On the other hand, rumors of large flour orders from Italy and Holland brought about a rally just before the windup of the day. Fine weather weakened the demand for corn. The weight of the big stock in sight promptly told against prices when it was apparent that no strength would be reflected from wheat. Miscellaneous holders unloaded oats. On the ensuing break, however, there was evidence of renewed cash call from the seaboard.

Provisions swung down with hogs and grain. Leading packers let go of holdings quite freely.
