NO SIGN OF STRIKE APPEARS IN OMAHA

Organizer, Following Refusal of the Builders to Grant Increase, Says No Talk of Strike

NEVER BEEN ANY AGITATION

No signs of a strike in the building trades appeared yesterday, and all jobs are proceeding as usual. Friday the building contractors refused to grant the increase in wages the bricklayers asked for and refused to state definitely a scale of wages be paid the carpenters.

W. D. Mitchler, organizer for the carrenters, said he felt the whole matter had been overplayed in publicity and that a strike was never contemplated by the carpenters, or, as far as he knew, by the bricklayers. "There is no occasion for a strike," he said, "and we have never threatened to strike. We have not agitsted a strike. The other night we had the biggest union meeting of carpenters that has been held here in a long time. and I'll leave it to any man there whether a strike was even mentioned. We have our problems to work out, and we expect to work them out gradually. As for a strike at this time, there is no agitation for it. The men are all working as usual."

No Threat of Strike. In regard to the demand made by the Allied Building Prades conference that only unon men be employed in any one of the five crafts, namely, the carpenters, bricklayers, plasterers, stonecutters and hoisting and portable engineers, he said.

"No threat of a strike was made in that request either. That was simply put out to the builders as part of an international plan and custom, and it is to work itself out gradually. We don't expect to bring all these things about in a day. It is a thing that is growing and will come about eventually regardless of what acion may be taken in Omaha."


