Saunders-Westrand Suit is Settle Out of Court for \$27,000

Trials of the Saunders-Westrand company's suits for \$27,000 against Lemson Bros. & Co. in Judge Estelle's district court, in which the plaintiff sought to recover money alleged transferred from it to the defendant by the late Sherman Saunders and William C. Sunderland, was brought to a close by dismissal of the suit, caused, it was said, by a settlement.

It was rumored that \$27,000 was the consideration for dismissal of the suit, the report being unconfirmed by attorneys on either side.

A stipulation in which no consideration was named will filed in court.

Dismissal of a similar suit brought by the Saunders-Westrand company against the Bartlett-Frazier company was also recorded.

All the parties to these suits were companies, which deal largely in grain transactions. One of the principal issues outlined in the suit which went to trial was the question of alleged illegality of grain dealers as carried on by the Chicago Board of Trade and its branches throughout the country.
