## MANY ALIENS NATURALIZED

Twenty-Two Hundred Foreigners Become Citizens in Douglas County in Last Ten Years.

### REQUIREMENTS OF NEW LAW

J. M. Gurnett, United States naturalization examiner with headquarters at St. Louis, has completed a review of the naturalization records in the office of the clerk of the district court for Douglas county. He asserts that since September 27, 1906, when the present federal naturalization law became operative, upwards of 2,300 aliens have been naturalized in Omaha, more than 80 per cent of whom were long-time residents, who had taken out their first papers before the enactment of the present law.

Under existing law, any alien who has declared his intention to become a citizen since September 27, 1906, must file application for final certificate of naturalization within seven years after the date of his declaration, or his rights under the declaration are lost, and he must make a new declaration of intention, waiting two more years before he is again eligible to file application for final certificate.

**No Effort Being Made.**  
There are now living in Greater Omaha more than 500 aliens whose declarations of intention are worthless by reason of the seven-year limitation. There are 4,158 aliens in the city whose declarations are sufficient to support an application for citizenship, but who are making no effort to take out final papers. Of the 4,334 aliens in the city whose first papers are less than seven years and more than two years of age and who are therefore eligible to apply for citizenship, only 376, or about 8 per cent have gone into court and become American citizens.

The government examiner attributes this circumstance, not to lack of a desire upon the part of aliens to become citizens, but to carelessness and to the fact that aliens are permitted in Nebraska to vote on their declarations.

**Purpose of Bureau.**  
The naturalization of foreigners is in charge of the bureau of naturalization, Washington, D. C. The chief purpose of this branch of the government's activities is to insure the legal naturalization of aliens of good moral character, desirable as citizens, who have lived in the United States at least five years. To expedite the administration of the law the country is divided into naturalization districts, each of which is under the jurisdiction of a chief examiner.

Nebraska is in the St. Louis district. Any communication relative to naturalization addressed to the Chief Naturalization Examiner, Custom House, St. Louis, will receive prompt and careful attention from attorneys who are expert in naturalization law. It is not necessary for a foreigner seeking American citizenship to employ an attorney, as the legal services of the chief examiner's office are at his disposal, says Mr. Gurnett.

## Redick Refuses to Stop Merger by an Order for Dundee

District Judge Redick has declined to grant a temporary restraining order in the injunction suit brought by residents of Dundee to prevent the consummation of annexation. He called attention to the fact that he had previously upheld the constitutionality of the annexation law. According to announcement of City Attorney Rine, Dundee officials have said they intend to refuse to turn over to Omaha officials the village records and property on Monday when the governor's proclamation will become effective. In that event, said Mr. Rine, the Omaha commission will go into court by a mandamus suit to compel the Dundee board to turn over its records to representatives of Omaha.

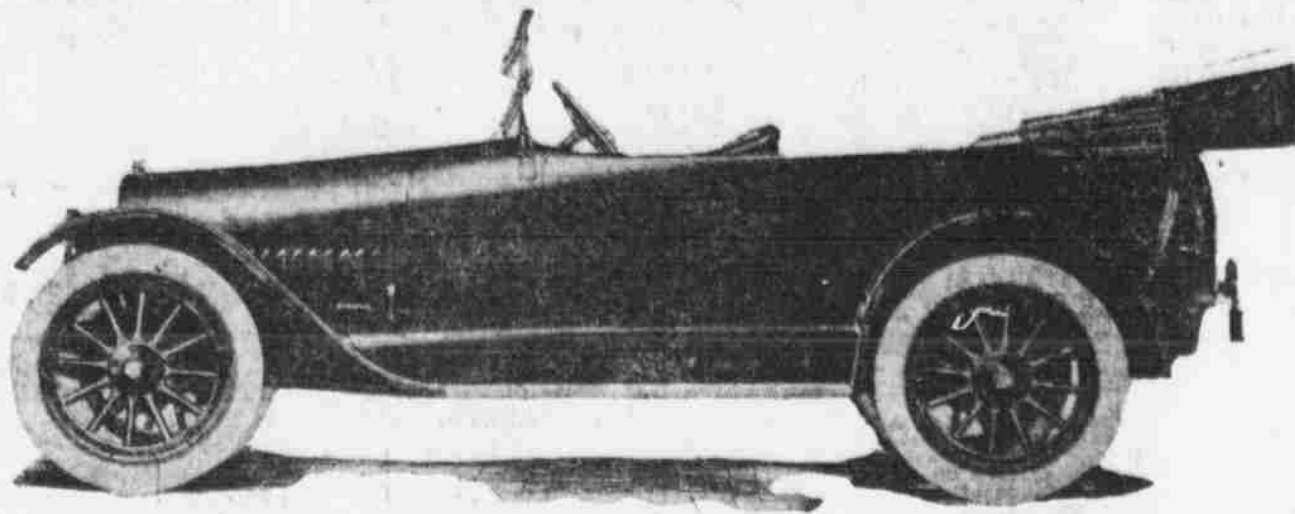
The supreme court will be asked to pass on the constitutionality of the annexation law, according to representatives of Dundee.

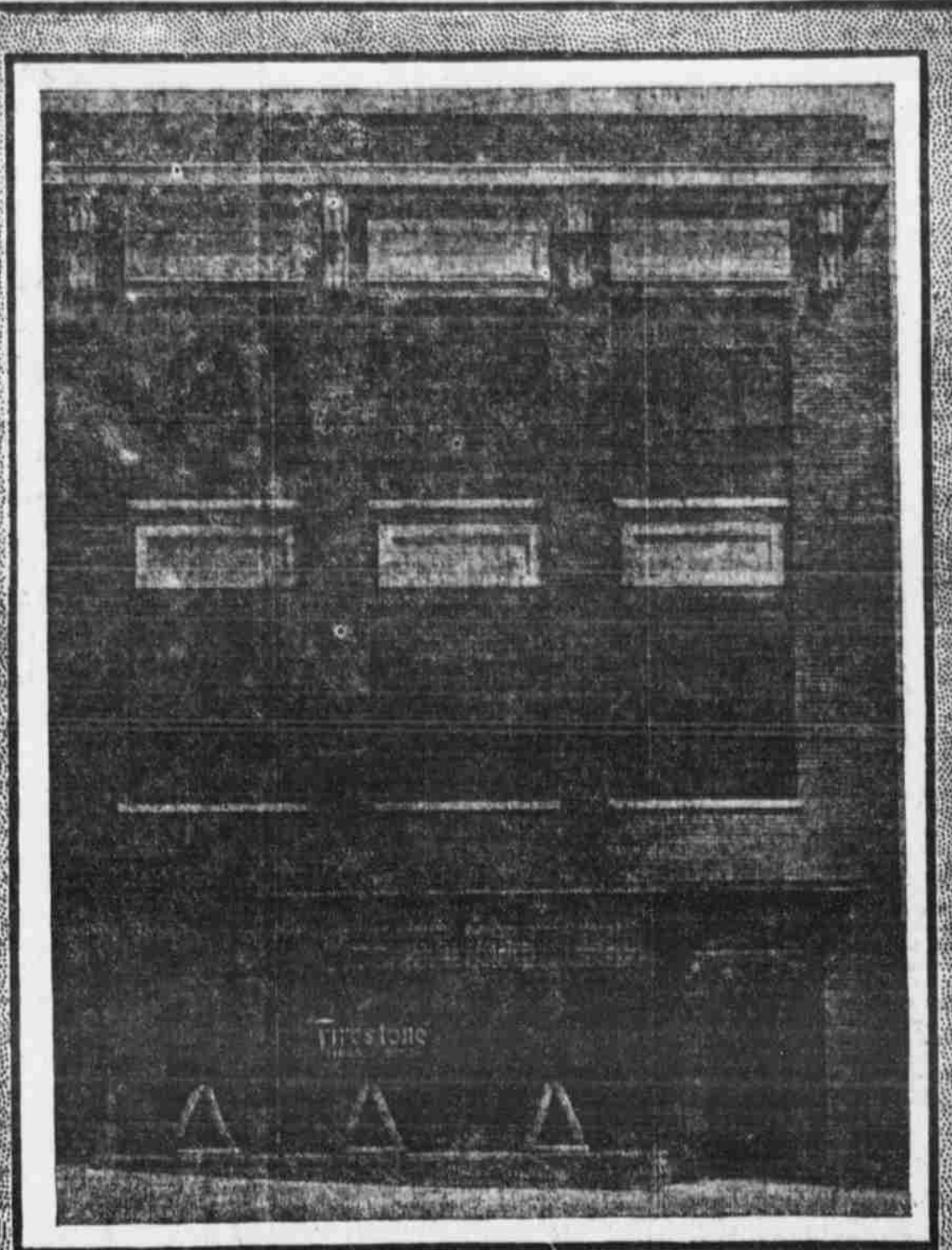
