Good Demand and Light Receipts Send Wheat Up Cent and a Half to Four Cents.

PREDICT UNSETTLED MARKET

OMAHA, July 17, 1915. Wheat was strong today, selling from 184 to 185 cents per bushel, and a good demand caused a good advance in wheat and corn.

There were no sales of rye or barley reported and those markets were nominally unchanged.

It is the general belief of the wheat traders that there is a more favorable weather over the greater part of the winter wheat country and larger receipts, unsettled market is expected.

The light stocks leave the market without any balance wheat, and with many of the spring wheat receipts, wheat and millers without stocks, an absorption of the new receipts is expected.

Clearance of wheat receipts unchanged to 194 higher and corn unchanged to 43 higher.

Primary wheat receipts were 112,000 bu. and shipments of 288,000 bu., against receipts of 1,200,000 bu. and shipments of 600,000 bu. last year.

Primary oats receipts were 50,000 bu. and shipments of 100,000 bu., against receipts of 625,000 bu. and shipments of 74,000 bu. last year.

NEW YORK STOCK MARKET

Further Boom in War Specialties Ends the Week. MANY NEW HIGH RECORDS.

NEW YORK, July 17.—Stocks ended the week almost as they began—with a further boom in the war specialties.

Among the common stocks, an Allyn-Chalmers common and preferred made striking gains on fairly large absorption in fact every issue in the so-called industrial and equipment divisions of the stock list was in demand, including in today's movement, rising to its highest quotation of the year.
