in Lumber Rates Local lumbermen have had what they term reliable information that the rall-reads have precisely agreed upon an advanced schedule on lumber rates. This

is causing some consternation in lumber circles, but the lumbermen say when the advance is announced it will be fought by all the lumbermen in the country. It

by all the lumbermen in the country. It is to come in the form of a reelassifica-tion of lumber in such a way that only the cheaper grades of rough stuff would be carried on the present rate charged for a large variety of lumber, while many grades new carried at this rate would be taken out and classified with the higher states under a higher tariff. Of course this matter will come to the Interstate Commerce commission for de-claton scener or later. Insidentally, when it does there is a possibility that the com-mission will make a general cleanup of the lumber rate situation. This is af-sumed by some of the best informed among the lumber traffic men, because of the fact that two noted cases, the hard-
