DIRIGIBLE AIRSHIP AT GROUNDS

Balloon ascensions and parachute drops are to be made every afternoon at the Ak-Sar-Ben carnival grounds at 4 o'clock.

A dirigible airship will be anchored on the grounds during the entire carnival as one of the free attractions, and the hot-air balloon will make daily ascensions.

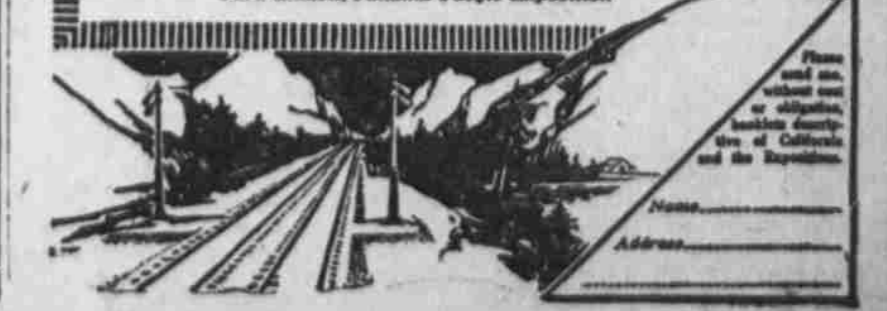
